What You Will Do

As our QA Associate, you will be responsible for establishing and maintaining the Good Production Practices (GPP) Quality Management System (QMS), ensuring regulatory compliance, and maintaining the validation status of the systems and equipment within the production facility.

The QA Associate role is a very diverse position where you will have the chance to work with all facets of QA at a unique and rapidly growing pharmaceutical company. Essential functions include:

- Reviewing and adapting our GPP QMS as we scale up production.
- Investigating and recording deviations, change controls, and complaints.
- Participating in QA projects (such as executing/setting up validation processes).
- Reviewing documentation (logs, batch records).
- Managing and keeping the QMS up to date.
- Participating in/conducting external and internal audits.
- Participating in the review of investigations, impact assessments, and other specialized reviews and reports.

- Upkeep of training records.
- Drafting and reviewing of procedures including work instructions.
- Monitoring production for any quality related issues.
- Performing vendor and material qualification.
- Inspecting incoming materials for defects.
- Maintaining the Quality Assurance Plan and Validation Master Plan.
- Executing validation and qualification related activities (i.e. Operational Qualification and Performance Qualification).
- Maintaining the validation status of systems and equipment.
